Team Lemon's Cardboard Boat Adventure, June 27, 2009

Team Lemon will attempt to set a world record for the Longest River Trip in a 4 Man Cardboard Boat. The River Run will start at **Coney Island** during the Paddlefest 2009 Weekend and finish at the **Cincinnati Serpentine Wall**.

The boat is constructed using only cardboard, duct and house paint. (no glue)

The boat will be on display for the Paddlefest 2009 Weekend, June 26 & 27.

If the boat (and crew) survive the trip, the boat will be on permanent display at the Cardboard Boat Museum, 311 Front Street, New Richmond, Ohio and will be raced in the August 22, 2009 Regatta (and following years).
